

### **LOCATION:**

S. M. Kaluti Composite Sports Residential C.B.S.E. School Chandargi, is situated on a small hillock near Chandargi, a small village in Ramdurg Taluk of Belagavi district. It is on the Belagavi - Bagalkot State High-Way in the middle, between the towns, Belagavi-73km and Bagalkot-70 km away from here. The school campus is spread over an area of 100 acres of serene greenery, about 25 acres of land is covered by an orchard with chikku, coconut and mango plantation. There are three small but beautiful gardens within the precincts of the main office and the Dinning Hall-Library Building

### **INFRASTRUCTURE:**

There are separate Academic and Administrative Blocks. Academic block includes spacious, well ventilated classrooms and are furnished with comfortable seating arrangement. Each classroom is equipped with modern dustless glass boards. Classes from VI to X standards of both Kannada and English mediums are conducted in a separate two storey School building which has a big Function Hall on the first floor of it.

#### **LABORATORY:**

There are well equipped separate laboratories for Physics, Chemistry and Biology. Practical based study of science is given priority. Practicals and experiments are done under the supervision of a special Science teacher. There is a Lab. attender to assist.

### **COMPUTER LAB:**

The Computer lab is equipped with modern computers. Computer Science form part of the syllabus. There are two Computer assistants who manage classes. There is an internet facility. The whole system is computerised.

### **ADMINISTRATIVE BLOCK:**

The main administrative office of the Institute is run in the Maharaja Building which was once the Summer Palace of His Highness, the Maharaja of Torgal. President's Chamber, Office and a Meeting Hall occupy the ground floor and the Conference Hall with attached large rooms meant for accommodation to VIP's do on the first floor



### **HOSTEL:**

A large full-fledged hostel building of unique architecture is newly constructed at an estimated cost of Rs. 1.5 crore. It is well furnished with new cots and beds in each decent dormitory. Limited number of wards are accommodated in each dormitory to make their stay highly comfortable one. There is 24 hours water supply here. Accommodation to faculty members is also arranged here in separate rooms to facilitate proper supervision and integration among the staff and the students. Separate hostel facility for the school.

### **MESS:**

Mess building is another attraction of the school. Large Dining Hall on the ground floor accommodates 700 students at a time. Separate kitchen with all modern facilities like steam, gas and bio-gas for cooking, a flourmill, separate storerooms and a bakery to supply bakery items to the students regularly are the features of the mess. About half a hundred mess workers including expert cooks are engaged on mess duty. The mess manager looks into it. Wholesome and nutritious food, not limited in quantity is provided in variety to the students. Care is taken to see that the mess service is good enough that the students do not miss their homes.

### **LIBRARY**

It occupies the first floor of the magnificent mess building which resembles the Parliament Bhavan in shape. It is equipped with a large collection of a variety of reference books on all disciplines to enrich knowledge. Text books, magazines, journals, periodicals and other ought to be read, books and periodicals are systematically stacked up areawise, It is furnished with ultra modern furniture for the comfort of readers. An expert librarian sees to it, There are multiple copies of books in three languages viz; English, Kannada and Hindi.

### **SUMMER COACHING CLASSES**

Running Summer Classes is a regular feature of the Institute. The school keeps the learners busy in their stride through conducting Special Coaching Classes in major subjects during Summer Vacation for which nominal fee is charged. To avoid them feeling monotonous, film shows, display of CDs on informative topics, variety of entertainment, group work, debates on interesting topics and class competitions form part of their progammes. ### **MEDICAL UNIT:**

The school has a full fledged medical unit within the precincts of dormitories. A qualified and experienced medical Officer takes careof the sick. Day and night medical service is provided and medicine is supplied free of cost to the sick students.

### **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION**

- If a selected candidate fails to join the school within the stipulated time, admission stands cancelled
- Candidates must pass 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> from C.B.S.E. school

### **SPECIAL COACHING:**

• Foundation Coaching Classes are managed by experts to train students for Competitive Tests and examinations like CET, NEET, JEE from time to time. for  $9^{th}$  and  $10^{th}$ 

### PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION 6th to 9th standard:

- Students have to appear for Entrance Test for admissions.
- Admission will be granted to those candidates who score satisfactory marks in the entrance test
- Merit Entrance Test is given priority
- Candidates must fill in and submit the prequalification Application form first which stands for eligibility for Entrance Test
- Names of selected candidates will be announced
- Eligible candidates will have to submit application forms for admission on or before the stipulated date.


### **KHELO INDIA**



### **WITHDRAWAL OF STUDENTS:**

- If parents wish to withdraw their wards from the school, they should inform the school authority well in advance showing satisfactory reasons regarding.
- 2. Reasons for withdrawal or expulsion of wards
  - a) disobeying the rules of the school
  - b) suffering from prolonged ill health
  - c) a fail in promotional examination
  - d) failure to pay the fees on time
  - e) if found unable to adjust with residential environment
  - f) malpractice in the examination
  - g) failure to produce necessary documents
  - h) misbehaviour.

#### **RULES OF THE SCHOOL:**

- 1. Full fees should be paid at the time of admission and they have to produce the following documents.
  - a) School Transfer Certificate
  - b) Marks card of the last Annual Examination passed
  - c) 4 recent Passport size photos of the student
- 2. Parents are permitted to see their wards only on the second Sunday of every month
- 3. Parents should not give money or costly things to their wards
- 4. When parents come to see their wards on Second Sundays, they must meet the class teachers and the concerned coaches to enquire about the progress of their children.
- 5. Parents should not contact their children directly on phone but they can do through the Principal in case of emergency
- 6. Letters written by students or parents will be scrutinised by the school authority
- 7. Parents are requested to co-operate with the school in maintaining discipline and tradition of the school
- 8. parents have to send their wards to the school on time on school reopening day after the vacations. Late-comers will be fined

- 9. If the parents want to take back their children from the school in the middle of the academic year, they may get the fees balance amount deducting half year's fees
- 10. Students are not permitted to go back home in the middle of the academic year
- 11. Parents have to bring the articles as per Annexure-I without fail.

The students who are competent in sports activities and who are capable to win medals in District, State and National Sports meet, will be provided special sports training with separate food and accommodation facility.


